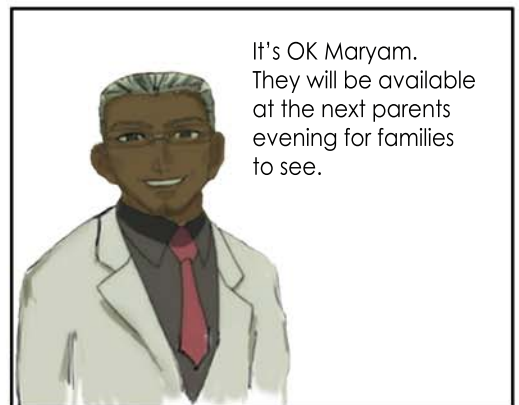
Did you find out if we can put them up on our profiles too?



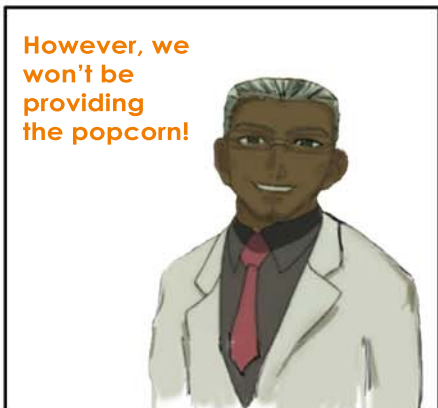
Sorry Kazi, that's a no-go. We can only put them up on a secure webpage, where you receive an invite to view the videos.

It's OK Maryam. They will be available at the next parents evening for families to see.



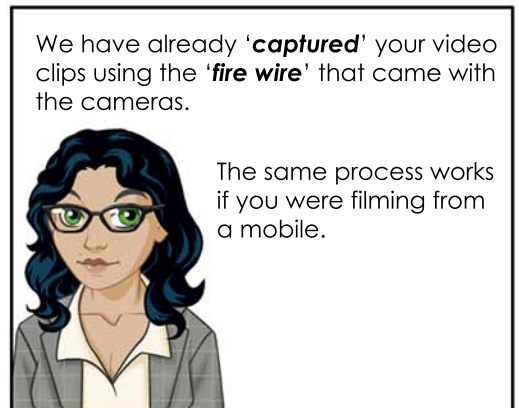
However, we won't be providing the popcorn!



Enter Ms. Born

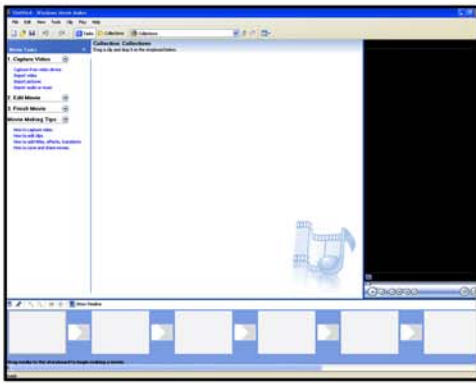
Hello class.

Today we are going to edit your videos with **Windows Movie Maker** - a free programme that comes with Windows.




We have already '**captured**' your video clips using the '**fire wire**' that came with the cameras.

The same process works if you were filming from a mobile.




First up - get into your groups and play all the clips you have recorded – taking note of their file name, content and time.




Can we change their names to make them easier to remember?

Yes Kazi, good idea!



Then create a folder and save all your clips there.

30 minutes later




We've got some really good stuff and it didn't take long to watch it all

In the first instance we will publish to **'this computer'** and then preview before uploading.

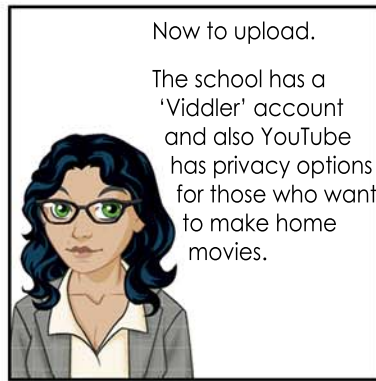


Hey psst, look it's got a file size option.

Now to upload. The school has a 'Viddler' account and also YouTube has privacy options for those who want to make home movies.



Please ensure that when you upload videos that they are marked as **private**



We are going to use Viddler today and the 'Batch Uploader' as we have multiple videos to upload.



Please select 'medium' quality and in sharing options – **Selected friends**.



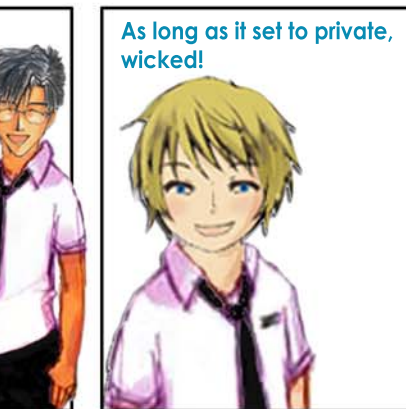
That didn't take long and was really easy.

Yeah, pain-free.

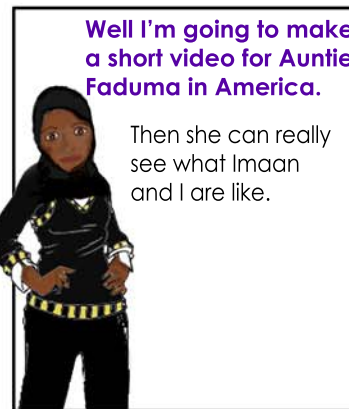


I bet I can upload video recordings from my mobile phone

Dad's got a webcam, we could record a message for Vinh and put it on my Facebook.

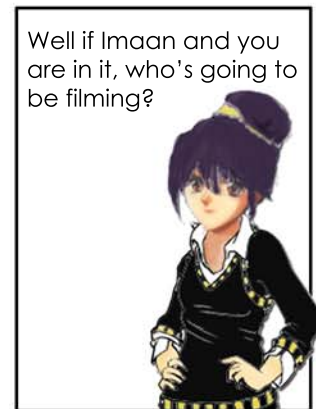


As long as it set to private, wicked!

Then she can really see what Imaan and I are like.

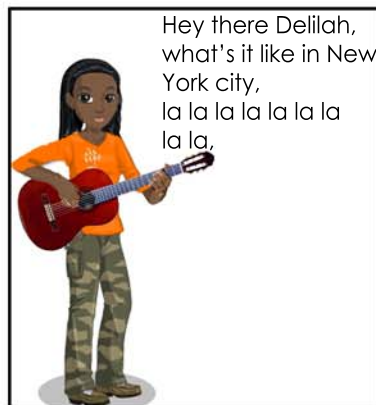


Well if Imaan and you are in it, who's going to be filming?

Top Tips

When putting together your video, think about who could be looking at it; and consider your content in terms of language, picture and information.

Make sure that you regularly check your privacy settings and anything that contains children is set to **'private'**.

Never film someone without their consent. **This is illegal.**

Editing videos does take time, making a storyboard or script of the exact information you want to get across will save time and help you keep to message.
